
Non Discrimination Notice

Piedmont Community Services gives public notice of its policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related statutes. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of **Race, Color, Sex, National Origin, Disability, Religion, Age, Sexual Orientation or Gender Identity** be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which Piedmont Community Services receives Federal financial assistance, including but not limited to Medicaid, Medicare or the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

Any person who believes that he or she has, individually, or as a member of any specific class of persons, been excluded from the participation in, been denied the benefits of, or been otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which PCS provides assistance, has the right to file a formal complaint. A complaint must be submitted within 180 days of the alleged discriminatory act. Written complaints should be filed with the Human Resources Department of Piedmont Community Services.
